A. Review 2021 Budget and Tax Rate Planning Calendar / Discussion and appropriate action


Susan Bentley, executive assistant for the County Judge, reviewed the proposed 2021 Budget and Tax Rate Planning Calendar with the court.

Commissioner Ortega moved to approve the calendar with changes as noted. Commissioner Esparza seconded the motion; motion passed unanimously.


4. Adjourn
